In the first time trial of the new season Trevor Leeding lived up to his name by winning the “Morning 10” on the tricky G10/70 country lane based course in an excellent time of 24:21. The 2014 “Evening 10 series” champion Simon Atkinson finished in second place just thirteen seconds behind; a remarkable performance given that he had been telling everyone all winter that he was out of form and would be retiring from competitive action. Since he does this every season he has now earned the nickname “Daffodil” due to his annual recovery and blooming in spring. The club’s veteran champion Mike O’Gorman was in third place, a further eight seconds back, with a time of 24:43.

It was good to see both Colin Barton and Jeremy Wooton back in action after long term injuries. Colin is obviously a bit out of practice though as he forgot to be on the line for his start time and thus incurred a 13 second penalty. Another rider for whom things didn’t quite go as well as planned was Martin Booker. Having put himself through an extensive winter training programme he then managed to take a wrong turn and go off course.

Young Shaeff Potter put in a good ride and was quickest of the juniors. What he didn’t put in though was his entry form in advance of the day!

The fastest ride of the morning was 23:44 by a private entrant Dominic Maxwell now of Sussex Revolution, having switched from WECC as from this season. He is now a second claim member of our club.
