Report

It was lovely to see Maureen Lock at the event this evening :- the first of the newly named Don Lock Memorial Series. And of course Andrew who was once again on the start line.

Unfortunately it was not quite the weather conditions that had been forecast earlier in the week. Rain affected later riders and the times for all riders were considerably slower than usual. By the end it was dark with torrential rain (which certainly made taking the signs down extremely unpleasant).

Big congratulations are due to Rick Hughes as he finally nails his first win in a club event. Clearly his dedication and structured training throughout the winter has paid dividends. After two second places in the evening 10 series last season he has achieved a major landmark.

Mike O’Gorman and Martin Booker continue their tussle as they finished in joint second place. In three events earlier this season Martin has finished a mere 6, 7 and 27 seconds behind Mike so he’s closed the gap and, like Rick, is benefitting from his winter training programme.

It is really good to see two juniors competing and putting up impressive times in those conditions and on road bikes. Schaeff Potter finished in an excellent fourth place and if he can do 23:16 tonight then we can expect his personal best of 22:56 to be bettered very soon this season. In his first time trial 11th place with a time of 24:47 is a super start for Aaron Hartley. He did ride in a couple of hill climbs at the end of last season and also rode from John O’Groats to Lands End with his father Dave so he looks to be developing into a classy all-rounder.

There were a number of fine personal performances. Also in his first ever time trial Neil Crowther’s time of 23:40 and 5th place is an eye-opener. Beforehand he was looking to go inside 25 minutes and he certainly more than achieved that. Our more senior competitors distinguished themselves as both Paul Townsley and Allan Orman (road bike) recorded good times. Nicole Patterson-Lett opened her defence of her ladies’ title with a good ride, whilst husband Clive opened his season with a very respectable time.
