Report

There was a good turnout for the first of the three short sharp challenges up Washington Bostal. Just three of the seven WECC riders had previous form in this event.

It's great to see our two enthusiastic juniors Harry and Ollie giving it a good go and enjoying the occasion. And they're both determined to return for even faster times.

Neil Crowther put in a hugely impressive first appearance. His 1:42.09 was faster than any WECC rider last season. Ian Newbold was the fourth debutant.

Having been club hill climb champion in 2014 and 2016 (in the Steyning Bostal Championships) Chris Putnam gained a good second place (his GH/95 PB being 1:42.70 in 2016). Rick Hughes PB is 1:51.0 from 2016, and Mike O'Gorman's is 1:48.40 from 2015.

Adrian Rodgers, now riding for Sussex Revolution VC, actually holds the club record from 2008 (when he was a WECC rider) at 1:27.64. In fact he has nine of the ten fastest WECC ever rides (Mark Newnham being the other with 1:29.30 in 2015). The course record holder is Stanley Kennett with 1:24.01 (set last year).



ESCA 100 - G100/861



Mike's 4:21:22 is a new course record for him and brought a clean sweep of the Excelsior 100 mile Club Championship, the Sussex CA 100 Vets Title (improving on his existing record time), the East Sussex CA 100 Vets title and the VTTA Surrey/Sussex 100 Vets title.

On scratch he came 17th in the ESCA event and 6th in the SCA event. The VTTA event is solely based on VTTA standards.
