In early September six club members including myself rode to Paris via Newhaven and Dieppe for a four day round trip. The ride mainly stayed on the Avenue Verte cycle route, encompassing many miles of well surfaced disused railway line with just a few sections of gravel track but even that was still rideable on road tyres. We covered in excess of 250 miles during the ride and although we didn't quite make it to the Eiffel Tower due to time constraints, it was a successful trip enjoyed by all.

Runs and Touring Coordinator, Dave Wilbor, is keen to repeat this trip next year if there is sufficient interest. There'll almost certainly be a few tweeks to enhance the trip, which will probably include an extra day to decrease the daily mileage but I can whole heartily recommend it for those who are interested.
