• Specialized S-Works Shiv TT, frame size 58. Year is 2014. I'd say that it would fit someone who is between 5'10" and 6'2" tall.

- USE Aero Carbon High Rise bar extensions, 320mm, 40 degree bend, with Wattshop carbon armrests.
- I also still have the original straight S-Works aero bars and armrests and all the original spacers to adjust the cockpit.
- SRAM Red 10 speed mechanical gears with RTC aero shifters.
- 55/42 SRAM TT chainrings.
- Zipp 808 NSW Carbon Clincher front wheel.
- Zipp Super-9 Carbon Clincher Disc rear wheel with Zipp wheel bag.
- Both wheels are year 2016 and are fitted with Specialized turbo cotton tyres. The wheels have had only 4 seasons (pre-COVID), of dry racing miles. Not used for training.
- Fizik Mystica TT saddle.
- Shimano Dura Ace carbon pedals.
- K-Edge Garmin TT computer mount.
- Elite Crono CX Aero Drinks Bottle & Cage.
- Rear aero light.
