Not all club members will have known Jim, a short squat Geordie who for countless years, with his lovely wife Connie, ran our clubroom canteen. Both of them gave so much for the club in service and in generosity and al they ever took in return was the pleasure it gave them.

Their campsite in the New Forest was regularly visited and a cooked breakfast after a New Forest time trial was a memory for many who have worn Excelsior colours over the years.

Born in 1909 Jim still attended club dinners until 2001, although poor his hearing meant that he only knew a little of the proceedings. After his Connie died Jim found life more and more confusing and his wish was to "join Connie as soon as possible". He went quite quickly after two strokes and we believe without suffering. We wish him well on his last solo ride and in his faith he firmly believed that a tandem awaited.
